

Jubilation Turns into Tragedy

Sub-inspector Mozammel Haq of Dhaka Medical College Hospital police camp told bdnews24.com that 11 fans were injured as a sand-laden truck hit them from behind near Banani footbridge around 1am on Saturday.

One of the injured, aged about 28, died after he was taken to the DMCH. The body was kept at the hospital morgue for autopsy.

At Shahbag, three fans were injured as a bus hit them from behind during the celebrations of Tigers' victory around the same time, he said.
